



RIC Energy and the Calanda Town Council seal an alliance to promote culture and sports in the municipality

Madrid, April 29, 2025. As part of the ***Raíces*** (*Roots, in English*) program, which reflects RIC Energy's social and territorial commitment, the company has signed a collaboration agreement with the Calanda Town Council to promote sports and culture in the municipality of Teruel.
